Tamluk: A journey Through Time & Heritage

Tamluk, a city in West Bengal, is a blend of ancient history and modern simplicity. Once known as Tamralipta, it was an important port during the Maurya and Gupta empires, with remnants of its maritime past still present in the area. The city thrives on its rich cultural heritage, evident in its festivals, folk music, and Bengali architecture. Despite the advancements in infrastructure, Tamluk retains a sense of calm, with its rural landscapes offering a peaceful contrast to urban life. Today, it balances tradition with progress, making it a unique example of how history and modernity coexist.

Matangini Hazra: The Silent Warrior Of Bengal Independence

Matangini Hazra, a revered figure in Indian history, was a brave freedom fighter from the Tamluk region in West Bengal. Born in 1870, she became a symbol of courage during the Indian struggle for independence. Her most notable act of defiance came in 1942, during the Quit India Movement, when she led a procession of villagers in Tamluk to protest against British rule.

Despite being over 70 years old at the time, Matangini Hazra carried the Indian tricolor and marched to the Tamluk police station, where she was confronted by British officers. When asked to stop, she continued her march, undeterred by the gunfire that followed. She was eventually shot and martyred, making her a symbol of resilience and patriotism.

Her sacrifice is remembered in Tamluk and beyond, and she is often referred to as the "Lady of Tamluk." Matangini Hazra's courage and unwavering commitment to India's independence continue to inspire generations of Indians in their fight for justice and freedom.

- Abstract of research papers should include Aims, Materials & Methods, Results & Analysis and Conclusion in brief.
- Abstract for case reports should include Introduction, Case particulars, Discussion and Conclusion in brief.

Required E-Poster Formate

- 1. An electronic poster (e-Poster) is a PowerPoint presentation in a specific format that will be displayed on a screen, in a **Landscape format**
- 2. All e-Posters must be prepared in English.
- 3. The slides must be created on the format provided with this mail.
- 4. Presentations not submitted on this template may not be accepted.
- 5. All e-Posters must include Title and only the presenter's name at the top of slide and the following elements:
- The e-poster has to be made on a single power point slide
- It should include Introduction, Objectives, Methodology, Results and Conclusions
- A completed footer should be added at the bottom of the slide with disclosure of interest if any
- 6. The minimum font size should be Arial 24 so that your e-Poster can be read by the delegates.
- 7. The information included in your e-Poster should reflect your accepted abstract.
- 8. Please **report at the registration desk** at the conference venue **well ahead** (by 8th March 9:00 A.M.) of your presentation time with the soft copy of your poster and get it uploaded in the system.
